**EGRSE – International Journal of Exploration Geophysics, Remote Sensing and Environment:** ISSN 1805-2266, since 1994 (two issues per year)


**Near Surface 2003:** 9<sup>th</sup> European Meeting of Environmental and Engineering Geophysics, organized by CAAG in Prague in September 2003




